Message from Mrs. Miller

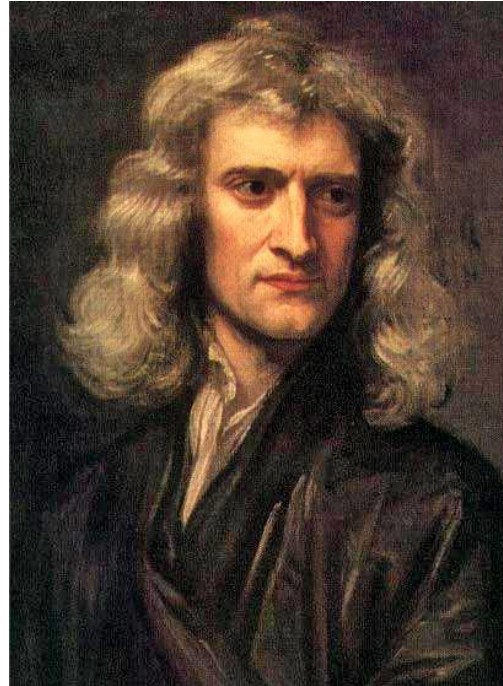
AP Classes will be livestreamed (7am - 9 pm) but will also be recorded so you can view them at a time convenient to you.

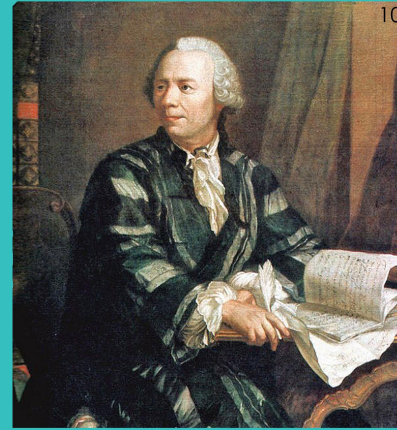
Review

I am still here for you and I want to help.

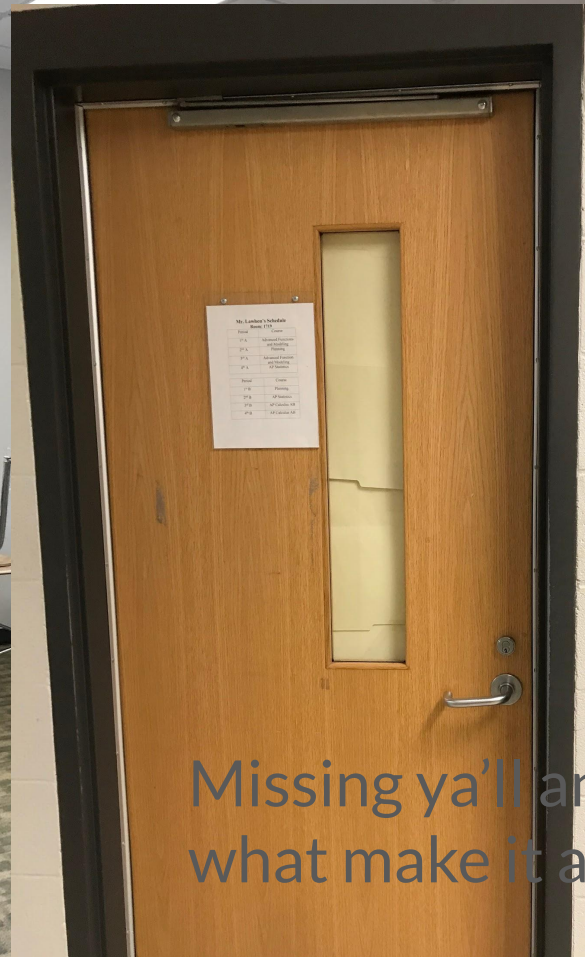
Protocol :

Go to your team leadership first.

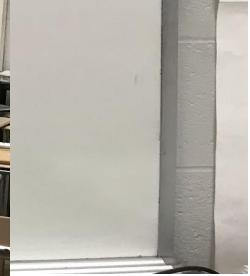
Still have an issue and team leadership has no answer from me. You can email me directly jlawhon@wcpss.net and I will respond with what I can.
